Appendix 2: Sub-Committees

1. Surveying & Monitoring:

- **Function:** Creates survey tools, makes recommendations, facilitates data sharing of detections/trapping.

2. Communications:

- **Function:** Develops communication plan, share, and deliver key messages as identified by the steering committee and sub-committees to the media and public. Prepares and consolidates update reports, FAQs. Ensures that online resources are current and in-sync across primary outlets (ODA, ODF, OISC).

3. Research:

- **Function:** Identifies and prioritizes research questions/objectives. Topics of interest may be proposed by Steering committee/other sub-committee/Task Force members

4. Wood waste & Utilization:

- **Function:** Identifies and creates pathways for treatment, removal, and disposal of infested/suspect infested wood. Seek alternatives for wood usage.

5. IPM:

- **Function:** Creates BMPs to address “the How”. Curates reference library of resources on important topics identified by partner subcommittees. Topics of interest may be proposed by Steering committee/other sub-committee/Task Force members

6. Training & Technical Assistance:

- **Function:** Implements training opportunities for multiple audiences. Topics/training needs are identified by Steering committee/other sub-committees. Provides tech assistance on IPM-BMPs generated by the IPM sub-committee. Training opportunities are shared to public by the communication sub-committee.

7. Funding:

- **Function:** Identify need for and sources for emergency response funds. If/once obtained, determine funding allocation plan.
