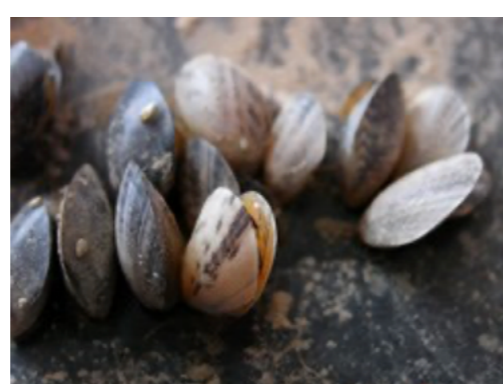
Oregon Invasive Species Network Newsletter
